



“Privacy Statement” (GDPR)

1. Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement explains how personal data is collected and processed within Clean Solutions Group B.V. and is completely in line with the basis of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

If you accept our privacy statement, you give explicit permission for the use and processing of your personal data in accordance with Article 6:1a of the GDPR.

2. Privacy policy

2.1 Applicability

We greatly value the privacy of our customers and correspondingly exercise the greatest possible care during the processing and protection of personal data.

We process data in accordance with the conditions set in the GDPR.

This means that only we decide what personal data are processed, for what purpose this is done, and in what manner this takes place. We are responsible for ensuring that your personal data is processed in a proper and careful manner in accordance with the GDPR.

We use this “**Privacy Statement**” to explain which data we process and for what purpose it serves.

2.2 We are responsible for your personal data

Clean Solutions Group B.V. is responsible for the processing of your personal data and greatly values the careful handling of personal data. This means, for example, that we handle personal data with due observance of strict confidentiality, that we have taken security measures to protect personal data against loss, unauthorized access or theft, and that we remove any data we no longer need for our activities.

2.3 Moment van ontvangst persoonsgegevens

We may process your personal data if you make use of our services. We may also process any data you share with us online. For example, by requesting or downloading information, by completing a contact form, and any data that can be retrieved from social media. This means that we can provide targeted and relevant information or can see what persons in specific areas are interested in Clean Solutions Group B.V. Naturally, we try to consider your personal interests as much as possible.

- Technical measurement data of equipment, such as IP address, cookies and the surfing behavior on our website.

2.4 Purposes

We verwerken alleen de persoonsgegevens die nodig zijn voor het kunnen verwerken van aanvragen of die bijdragen aan het realiseren van een kwalitatieve samenwerking. Concreet gezegd verwerken we uw persoonsgegevens zodat we onder andere;

- Process and manage your request;
- Keep records concerning our (client) file;
- Inform you about new developments and schedule appointments;
- Inform you about general trends in the sector;
- Keep track of who we can and cannot approach for our campaigns;
- Manage our financial records so that we can comply with (statutory) financial and tax obligations;
- Test and improve the quality of our services such as gaining insight in the performance of the support section and our website;
- Carry out market research, so that we can better tailor our services to the needs of our clients;
- Maintain web statistics (and be able to enable sharing through social media).
- Acquire new clients;
- Carry out internal and external audits of our services;
- To process (open) applications.

2.5 Provision to third parties

The (provided)personal data are only provided to third parties if this is necessary for the delivery of ordered products or service. For transportation of our products we use third parties, which take care of the delivery of products. Clear arrangements (by means of an agreement) are made with third parties with whom we share personal data. The personal data are removed when they are no longer used. The data will not be provided to parties if this is not necessary or legally required.

2.6 Secure and store

We take appropriate (security) measures to minimize misuse and unauthorized access to personal data. Only the necessary persons have access to the data. We do not store the data longer than necessary or are legally permitted.

2.7 Rights

Within the framework of the General Data Protection Regulation you are entitled to inspect, rectify or delete the personal data and you can also object to the processing of the personal data. The data can be transferred to external parties at your request.
